Other than the 'Genie in the lamp', this play is unique in its plot, characters and outcome, while addressing relevant issues.


insurance fraud scam. Granny saves the day with her karate moves and all is well... or so we think. In the end, everyone learns a lesson about honesty and staying true to oneself.
